INTRODUCTION

This bibliography on the spectacled bear, Tremarctos ornatus, is the result of an attempt to collate citations of as much literature as possible on the species. This bibliography is a combined effort of Jeffrey Jorgenson and Diana Weinhardt and is the most comprehensive bibliography of spectacled bear literature available. Citations were obtained by the following means: 1.) review of entries of journals with mammalogical articles, 2.) review of the literature cited sections of publications dealing with the spectacled bear, and 3.) review of abstracting services such as the Wildlife Review and Zoological Record. Citations are as complete as the sources would permit, and articles were categorized into 12 subject areas based on their emphasis. Many of the publications consider more than one topic and these citations are cross-indexed. The twelve major subject areas are:

1. **Physiology** - includes papers dealing with skeletal material (skins, bones, skulls).
2. **Paleontology** - includes papers dealing with fossil faunas.
3. **Behavior and Home Range** - includes papers discussing general behavior, social organization, home range and movement, interactions with other species, activity patterns, and habitat utilization.
4. **Captive Management** - includes papers dealing with the management of bears in captivity (e.g., reproductive strategies, diets, housing, and general management protocols).
5. **Distribution** - publications that describe the past and present occurrence of the species.
6. **Food Habits** - includes references on food items and feeding methods of wild and captive specimens.
7. **Legislation and Status** - includes papers on legislative aspects and status of bears in the wild.
8. **Medical** - articles dealing with medicine, parasites and diseases.
9. **Popularized Accounts** - includes articles from zoo and nature magazines, wildlife agency publications, and newspapers.
10. **Reproductive Biology** - includes papers dealing with litter size, length of breeding season, captive denning arrangements, genetics and growth, and development of young.

11. **Taxonomy** - original species description, revisions, and classification.

12. **General References** - includes miscellaneous papers that do not fit into other categories, and general progress or status reports. Other reports may deal with aspects of reproduction, food habits, populations, or other categories, but in such a limited way that they were not cross referenced in those sections. Included in this section, listings for the Spectacled Bear Studbook.

EINLEITUNG

Die Bibliographie des Brillenbaeres, Tremarctos ornatus, ist der Erfolg eines Versuches so viel als möglich gesammelter Zitierungen der Literatur des Brillenbaeres zu kollationieren. Diese Bibliographie ist durch gemeinsamer Bemuehung von Herrn Jeffrey Jorgenson und Fraeulein Diana Weinhardt ermöglicht worden, und sollte zur Zeit die inhaltsreichste Bibliographie der Brillenbaerliteratur vorhanden zu sein. Anfuehrungen wurden auf folgender Weise erreicht: 1.) Nachpruefung der Beschreibungen vorhandener Journale die mammologische Aufsaetze enthielten, 2.) Nachpruefung der Literatur die sich voraussaetzlich mit dem Brillenbaer abgibt, 3.) Nachpruefung der abstrakten Ausgaben, naemlich der "Wildlife Review" und Zoological Record. Zitierungen sind also so komplett als die Nachricht quelle es erlaubt. Zitierungen wurden auch je nach Betonung von Bekanntmachungen kategorisiert. Viele der Veröffentlichungen erwähnen mehr als einen Gegenstand, Zitierungen wurden mit Querindex in die folgenden Kategorien eingereiht. Zwölf Hauptgegenstaende wurden unterschieden, und die beiliegenden Unterlagen enthalten folgendes:

1. **Anatomie** - enthaelt Beschreibungen die sich mit skelettartigem material befassen (Häute, Knochen, Schädel).

2. **Archaeologische Referenzen** - enthaelt Beschreibungen die sich mit fossiliensfauna von archaeologischen Fundplaetzen befassen.

3. **Benehmen und Heimgebiet** - enthaelt Beschreibungen die generelles Benehmen diskutieren, soziale Organization, Heimgebiet und Bewegung, Wechselwirkung mit anderen Spezien, Beweglichkeit sverhalten, und Aufenthaltsanwendung (naemlich Zooanlage).

4. **Fangsbehandlung** - enthaelt Beschreibungen die mit zoologischer Verwaltung handeln, sowie auch Fortpflanzungsstrategien, Ernaehrung (Diet), Wohnanlagen, und generelle Verwaltungsprotokolls.

5. **Verbreitung** - Veroeffentlichkeiten die als Basis fuer vergangene und jetzige Gesamtzahlgebiete verwendet werden.

6. **Futtergewohnheiten** - enthaelt Referenzen im Wilden und in Fanganstalten.

7. **Gesetzgebung und Status** - enthaelt Veroeffentlichkeiten ueber gesetzliche Bezaege und Wildtierstatus.

8. **Medizinische Behandlung** - Artkeln die sich mit Parasiten und Krankheiten des Brillenbaeres befassen.

9. Popularisierte Ansichten-enthaelt Beschreibungen von Zoos und Naturmagazinen, Wildlebenagentur, Beschreibungen und Zeitungen.

10. **Fortpflanzungsbiologie** - enthaelt Papiere die sich mit Wurfgroesse, Laenge der Befruchtungssaison, Innenboxeinrichtung und deren Zusammenstellung, Entstehung, Entwicklung und Wuchs der Jungtiere.

11. **Taxonomie** - Originalbeschreibungen, Revisionen, Naturgeschichte und Kladdifizierung.

12. **Diverse Referenzen** - enthaelt generelle Papiere die nich in andere Kategorien passen, und generellen Fortschritt oder Statusberichte. Generelle Berichte gefassen sich mit Hinsichten von Reproduktion, Futtergewohnheit, Gesamtzahl oder andere Kategorien, aber in einer solchen beschraenkten Weise dass keine Querrefenzen in den Bestimmten Abteilungen haben. In dieser Abteilung befindet sich ein Verzeichnis des Brillenbaerstammbuches.

INTRODUCION

La bibliografia del oso de anteojos, Tremarctos ornatus, es la resulta del ataque a recoger tan mucho literatura como posible sobre el oso de anteojos. Esta bibliograpia es un esfuerzo en la parte del el senor Jeffery Jorgenson y la señorita Diana Weinhardt. Es posible que res lo mas inclusiva bibliographia en existencia.

Anotaciones estaban obtenido por lo siguiente: 1.) Revistas de periodicos y diarios quien tienen articulos de mamalogia, 2.) Revistas de la literatura en publicaciones tratan con los osos de anteojos, 3.) y revistas de servicios los que The Wildlife Review y Zoological Record. Desde muchas de las publicaciones consideraban mas que uno asunto o tema, doce categoria eran distinguidas:

1. **Anatomia** - publicaciones manifestando material de esqueleto (cutis, hueso, craneo).

2. **Referencias Arqueologicas** - incluyen papeles que examinan los fosiles de sitios arqueologicos.

3. **La Conducta y Extension** en que los osos se mueven de casa - este categoria discute la conducta general, movimiento, organizacion social, accion reciproca con otras especie de animales, y utilization de la habitacion.

4. **El manejo en cautidad** de los osos - articulos manifestando ideas de dieta, reproducion, habitacion y manejo general protocolo

5. **Distribucion** - publicaciones usados para ensenar areas de poblacion desde lo pasado a la presente.

6. **Modos caracteristicos de alimento** - estos modos son discutidos por los animales en cautido y en el yermo.

7. **Legislacion** - incluye discursos de las leyes gobernando los animales silvestres.

8. **Medical** - incluye discursos de parásitos y enfermedades de los osos de anteojos.

9. **Periodos Popularizados** - incluye informacion de los periodicos de zoo y periodicos de la naturaleza.

10. **Reproduccion** - incluye el tamano de la litera period de prenado; la longitud de la estacion de la crianza; la genetica, crecimiento, y desarollo de los jovenes.

11. **Taxonomia** - descripciones ordinales, revisiones, la historia natural y clasificacion.

12. **Las Referencias Miscelaneos.**
