FEDERAL SPECIFICATION

HERBICIDE, 2,4-DICHLOROPHENOXYACETIC ACID (SALTS AND ESTERS)

This amendment, which forms a part of Federal Specification O-II-200a, dated January 31, 1953, was approved by the Commissioner, Federal Supply Service, General Services Administration, for the use of all Federal agencies.

Page 1, paragraph 2.1: Add the following at the end of the paragraph: "to the extent specified herein."

Page 1, paragraph 2.1: Delete "PPP-D-760-Drums and Pails, Metal (5 and 16.64 Gallon)" and substitute "PPP-P-704-Pails: Shipping, Steel (1 Through 12 Gallon)."

Page 2, paragraph 2.2: Add the following at the end of the first sentence: "to the extent specified herein."

Page 3, section 4: Add the following paragraph:

4.1 The supplier is responsible for the performance of all inspection requirements as specified herein. Except as otherwise specified, the supplier may utilize his own or any other inspection facilities and services acceptable to the Government. Inspection records of the examinations and tests shall be kept complete and available to the Government as specified in the contract or order. The Government reserves the right to perform any of the inspections set forth in the specification where such inspections are deemed necessary to assure supplies and services conform to prescribed requirements.

Page 3, paragraph 4.1 and succeeding paragraphs: Renumber.

Page 6, paragraph 5.2.1.2.2: Delete and substitute:

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5.2.1.2.2 Five-gallon.—Material shall be furnished in steel pails conforming to type I, class 3 of Federal Specification PPP-P-704.

Page 7, paragraph 5.3.1.1. Delete and substitute:

5.3.1.1 Labeling.—Unless otherwise specified, each container of 2,4–D formulation shall be labeled with instructions for use and marked in compliance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and other applicable existing Federal laws. Date of pack and lot number shall appear on the label.

Page 8, add the following paragraph:

6.4 Transportation description. Transportation descriptions and minimum weights applicable to this commodity are:

Rail:

Weed killing compounds, not otherwise indexed by name.

Carload minimum weight 40,000 pounds.

Motor:

Weed killing compounds, not otherwise indexed.

> Truckload minimum weight (W) 36.6 pounds, (W) subject to Rule 34, National Motor Freight Classification.
