Request for Analysis of Sprayed Kromekote Cards

APCC (PGVED-1/Lt Goodwin)

1. A representative of the Armament Laboratory witnessed a demonstration of a new nozzle design on 20 Sep 67. About 100 Kromekote cards were placed perpendicular to the path of the spray aircraft. The defoliant which was dispensed was a mixture composed of 33.5% 2,4D; 31.9% 2,4,5T, and 34.6% kerosene (all are volume percent); the density of this material is unknown.

2. ATCB requests that the CB Laboratory examine these cards to determine droplet spectrum and mass median diameter in support of Project 5172.
